


# Symbiosis School for Liberal Arts 5 Ft. Apart



Please carefully go through all the rules and sign up for the games which interest you. We have retained the OG games and added some new games for this year.

#### 1. Charades/Dumb Charades- Zoom/Meet

A number between 1-10 will be chosen randomly for each team. The chosen number will determine the genre of the movie. After which, a movie will be given to the person acting with the help of a random generator.

You will get 1 point for guessing the movie within 120 seconds and one extra point for guessing it under 60 seconds.

#### 2. Pictionary- Zoom

Taking turns, each team draws a picture of a word chosen from a random word generator. There will be four rounds with increasing levels of difficulties.

The team with the most points at the end is the winner.

#### 3. Trivia- Zoom/Meet

The guiz will be held on Zoom/Meet.

There will be a total of five rounds. Each question will be worth 2 points, passed questions will be worth 1 point.

Round 1- General Knowledge- 15 seconds to answer each question

#### 8/14/2021

Round 2- Sports- 15 seconds to answer each questions

Round 3- Geography- 15 seconds to answer each question

Round 4- Picture round- 15 seconds to answer each question

Round 5- Rapid fire- 10 seconds to answer each question. No questions passed.

#### 4. Read my lips- Zoom

To play, one participant will mute the mic, and then speak a word or phrase. The other players must try to guess the word or phrase correctly. Players have **one minute** to figure out the message. The phrase will be given by a member of the sports council.

You will not be allowed to give any hand signals like charades. Try and enunciate your words clearly. The team with the most guessed phrases will win.

#### 5. Guess the Song-Zoom

The song genre will be randomly chosen from a spin wheel. A song will be played for 15-20 seconds. The participants can guess the song's name for a point and the artist for another.

#### 6. Codenames-Zoom/meet

The game board consists of 25 randomly generated words.

There are two teams: red and blue.

Of the 25 words, nine belong to the team randomly selected to go first and eight belong to the other team. There are also seven neutral words and a bomb word.

Each team has a spymaster that knows exactly which words belong to their team and the opposing team, which words are neutral, and which is the bomb. The objective of the game is for the spymasters to send clues to their field operatives (the other players on their team) to help them decode all of their team's words without uncovering the bomb. The team that decodes all of their words first wins; if a team uncovers the bomb, the other team wins.

The spymaster will have to think of one-word clues which relate to the bunch of words displayed on the screen. The rest of the team will have to discuss amongst themselves and select the word/s which relate to the hint given by their spymaster.

The spymasters will also have an option to select the number of words which relate to their hint.








### Symbiosis School for Liberal Arts Red Carpet 2021
