Course Description

Living with Climate Change is an elective subject that is designed to develop an understanding of the science of climate change by exploring various causes and impacts pertaining to the phenomena. Students are encouraged to understand the pressing polity and equality issues in the contemporary climate change debate. The objective of the activities put forth in this subject, is to make students aware of the existing perspectives at three levels- international, national, and personal, in relation to the problem. The course aims towards generating an interest among students, to explore a range of actions possible to address the prevalent crisis of climate change, and to think of plausible solutions.

The subject covers a variety of topics, like insights from the IPCC, causes of GHGs, the impact of the global perspectives, the impact on India, understanding the positions of the vulnerable groups, the diverse issues of mitigation, and climate change scepticism.
