Course Description:

Legislative process has become a complex and dynamic way to reflect policy of the government into statutes. Today, it is necessary for a citizen to have a basic understanding of the way the laws are made, and the way the state uses its power to affect the social and economic growth of our nation. The objective of this course is to emphasize that law is an instrument of social change, and that the state tries to answer contemporary questions through lawmaking. The direct result of the growth of administrative powers in the hands of state machinery, is emergence of administrative law.

This course is meant to be a brief outline of location of law-making powers, the processes and the limitations of the statutory activity in the Indian scenario. The objective is to develop a practical point of view towards the complexity of lawmaking processes. It covers a wide range of topics, such as making of a legislation, interplay of state action and public opinion, delegated legislation and administrative discretion and remedies.
