Course Description

The introductory course will help students appreciate and understand the art of theatre making. The course will introduce students to various tools and fundamental principles of theatre making process, through which they will gain a deeper understanding of, the role of performer as creator, the construction and the creation process.

The course will give a well-rounded understanding of the basics of theatre making to students, covering a variety of topics from the exploration of the relationship between the performer and the audience, understanding the devising process of theatre making and generally enhancing the physical, emotional, imaginative and cognitive playfulness of the performer.

The lectures will be taught via practical classes, mentoring of practice, observation and critical analysis of work in progress, group projects, use of visual aids and field trips.
