Course Description:

This course is aimed at students who have a basic understanding of the Urdu language and want to focus on written and oral communication. The course will focus on improving fluency and accuracy of sentences and functional language. During the lessons students will develop written and oral communication skills in a number of different areas including everyday situations and during their daily lives. The fourth module ups the ante by teaching students to demonstrate comprehension through their writing skills, practice their oral skills with clear pronunciation and fluency and also further practice of reading and writing of the Urdu alphabet, and teaching them to demonstrate an increased awareness in interpretation of context and appropriateness of language use. The primary methods of teaching will once again be in the classroom with group discussion being a priority along with the utilization of audio-visual aids.
